Containing ninety one acres and one hundred and fifty five perches of land, with the customary allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. situated in the Township of Ligon County of Luzerne and State of Pennsylvania, It being the property of Parrey No. 1st Survey under four degrees variation from the Luzerne County established Meridian Line, on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of October A.
