



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June, 1772, a survey was made on the 3^d of July following of a certain lot of ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland, marked in the General plan of said Town, seventy five, and granted to David M. Murtrie, containing in breadth North and South Fifty seven feet six inches, and in length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet, bounded westward by Broad Way, Southward by Lot number seventy six, Eastward by River Alley and Northward by Lot number seventy four, as by the general Plan of said Town, remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear.
