In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property bearing date the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland being numbered in the general plan of said town sixty six, and granted to Jacob Barge (who hath conveyed his right to the above said Jesse Lukens) containing in length North and South sixty feet and in breadth East and West two hundred and thirty feet, bounded Westward with Lot number sixty five Northward with Mulberry alley Eastward by Lot number Two and Southward with Shamokin Street, as by the general Plan thereof remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear Returned into the Secretary's Office the 2^d day of January 1773.
