



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for Aaron Levi on a certain Lot of ground situate on the South Side of Dewberry Street in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland and marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Twelve, Containing in Breadth East and West on Dewberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North & South two hundred & thirty feet Bounded Northward by Dewberry Street, Eastward by Lot Number one hundred & Eleven, Southward by Mulberry Alley; and Westward by Lot Number one hundred and thirteen. Returned into the Secretary's office the 29th day of April, ¹⁷⁷⁴ for Aaron Levi by Warrant dated the 27th April Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this ninth day of August 1905.
