



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Great Spring Field situated on the Path leading from Standing Stone to Frankstown about twelve Miles above Standing Stone & about three Miles above the Fox Tavern at the Foot of the Canoe Mountain adjoining Land of George Nelson & George Meyer including a large Limestone Spring in Barie Township in the County of Bedford Containing two hundred & Seventy-eight Acres and the usual Allowance of Six P. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 12th Day of November 1773 for Martin Lawman in Pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 25th Day of June in the same year by
