



In Pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for Conrad Laffler on a certain lot of ground situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general Plan of said Town Number Thirty Containing in Breadth East and West on Shamokin Street Sixty feet, and in Length North & South Two hundred & Thirty feet Bounded Northward by Shamokin Street aforesaid Eastward by Fawn Street, Southward by Barberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number Twenty Nine Returned into the Secretarys office the 9th day of February 1775.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-second day of September 1905.
