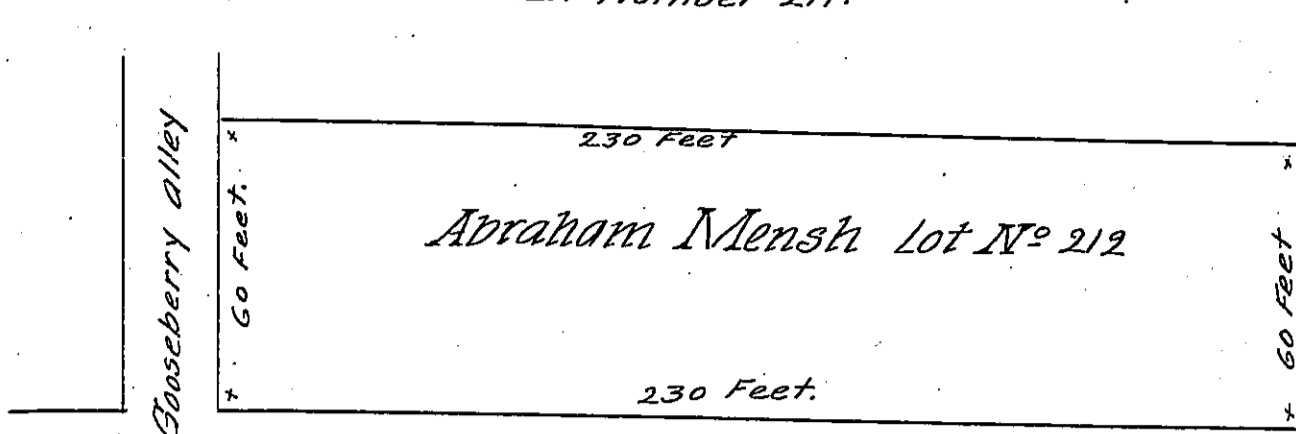


Lot Number 211.



Deer Street.

In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for William Mc Murray on a Certain Lot of ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general Plan of said Town Two Hundred and Twelve Containing in Breadth East and West East and West on the North side of Poakberry Street Sixty feet and in length North and South Two Hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Poakberry Street Sixty feet. Eastward by Lot Number Two Hundred and Eleven, Northward by Gooseberry alley, and Westward by Deer Street, Returned into the Secretary's office the 25th March 1776 for Abraham Mensh by Warrant dated the 20th same Month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this sixth day of October 1905.
