



Situate on Wolfs Camp run, in Londonderry township Bedford County Containing 82 acres 158 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed by Michael Reed Esq. the 23<sup>rd</sup> of October 1850. Being part of a tract that originally contained 178<sup>ac</sup> & allowance Surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> of May 1819. on Warrant dated 4<sup>th</sup> of Febr. y 1819 granted to Ludwick Lyberger for 170 a.s.

The above 82<sup>ac</sup> 158<sup>ps</sup> returned for patenting the 22<sup>nd</sup> of Febr. 1854- Courses according to the true bearings
