



By Virtue of a warrt from the Hon^{ble} Proprietarys Dated the first Day of November anno Dom/1735 Theris Survey'd unto Thomas Heald Two hundred and fifty five acres of Land with the allowance of 6 Cent in Lancaster County on the west side of Susquehannah River and begins at a white oak near a Corner of Joseph Bennetts Land Then South forty Degrees westerly Two hundred and Eighty Eight perches to a white-oak Thence North fifty Degrees Westerly one hundred and fifty Pches to a white-oak Thence North forty Degrees East Two hundred and Eighty Eight Pches to a white-oak Thence South fifty Degrees Easterly one hundred and fifty perches to the place of Beginning.
