



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 9th of February 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Isaac Leet Jun^r for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4th of January 1794. Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the West Side of Big Beaver Creek adjoining Land Granted to Jonathan Leet Called Salvo Containing four Hundred and twenty Acres and the Usual allowance of Six p^{ct} Cent for Roads.
