



Whereas William Latta in pursuance of a warrant dated Feby 4th 1786 obtained a survey containing three hundred and fifty four and an half acres and 25 perches and allowance of 67 cent situate in Huntington township in the county of Westmoreland and whereas the said William Latta convey'd to Moses Latta Junr fifty three acres and 148 perches and allowance of the same tract and the Heirs of s^d w^m Latta are now desirous to obtain a Patent for the remainder of the tract aforesaid therefore at their request I have made the above draught containing three hundred acres and 132 perches and the allowance of 67 cent taken from the draught of Benjamin Lodge late Deputy surveyor now in my office.
