



The above is the draft of a survey made Jan 27<sup>th</sup> 1829 in pursuance of a warrant dated Dec 8<sup>th</sup> 1828 granted to Jno Hays for seventy five acres of land being improved Situate on Mill Creek Greene township Beaver County containing sixty seven acres thirty five per and the allowance of six percent

The above is an extract from the Survey Book the land has been in dispute but it has been decided by a Court and Jury in favour of Mr Hays sometime ago.

Returned at the request of Mr Hays May 7<sup>th</sup> 1831
