



A Draught of a tract of land called the Green Meadows situate on the head of the West Branch of Susquehannah including the Fork thereof about four miles above the Canoe Place adjoining lands of Robe(obl) Gorgee in Frankstown Township in the County of Bedford containing two hundred & eighty Acres and the usual allowance of six $\frac{7}{8}$ cent for roads & Surveyed the 14th Day of November 1774 for Mordecai Lewis in pursuance of a warrant dated the 6th day of August 1773 by:
