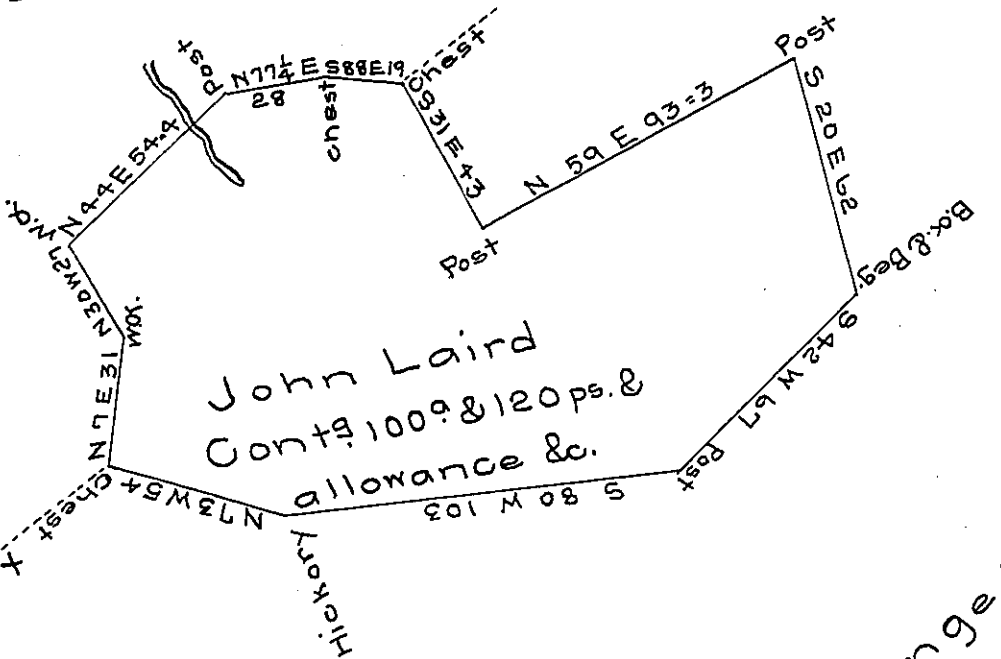


Andrew Duncan's other land in right of John McClong



John Laird's other called the Bronge Estate

Situate in Chanceford township in the County of York containing as above set forth 100<sup>1/2</sup> & 120 perches & allowance &c. Surveyed on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1804. In pursuance of a warrant for 100<sup>1/2</sup> granted to John Laird bearing date the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March Anno Domini 1786 — and now at the request of the owner Andrew Duncan I am desired to make return of the draught as calculated &c. the 27<sup>th</sup> day of July Anno Domini 1809.
