



Situate in Codorus township in the county of York containing as above set forth 56<sup>8</sup> & 24 perches and the usual allowance, being part of a larger tract of land which was originally surveyed by Moses M<sup>c</sup>Clean late D.S. on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November 1785 for Jacob Keiser in pursuance of a warrant dated September 8<sup>th</sup> 1785. And now on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1808. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land at the instance and request of the present owner Conrad Meyer who desired me to make return of the draught.
