Situate formerly in York township but now in Windsor township in the County of York containing as above set forth 106¹/₂ & 72 perches and allowance &c. being part of a larger tract of land originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 20th. day of January 1752. for John Legate in pursuance of a warrant bearing date the 18th. day of December AD^o 1751. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land by William Kersey late D.S. on the 24th. of the 9th. month 1792. And now at the request of the present owner Ulrich Neaff I am desired to make return of the draught as calculated examined and corrected the 12th. day of July AD^o 1809.
