Being part of a larger tract of land originally surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 29<sup>th</sup>. of the 4<sup>th</sup>. month AD<sup>o</sup> 1793 in pursuance of a warrant for 75<sup>9</sup> granted to Andrew Smith bearing date the 26<sup>th</sup>. day of October AD<sup>o</sup> 1791 Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land for Dewalt Snider the present owner- and at his request I have made return of the draught as calculated and examined the 30<sup>th</sup>. day of June Anno Domini 1809 -
