The above is a draught of survey made September 24th 1785 on a certificate granted by the Commissioners to Henry Fullenwider dated February 18th 1780 called Fox Chase containing 299 acres & ~~1/2~~ ^{1/2} & is situate in Washington County. A true Copy of the Certificate viz.

We the commissioners for adjusting claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania & Ohio do hereby certify that Henry Fullenwider is entitled to three hundred acres of land in the County of Ohio on Buffalo Creek to include his settlement made in the year one thousand seven hundred and seventy four. Given under our hands at Cox's fort the eighteenth day of February 1780 in the fourth year of the commonwealth.
