



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the tenth Day of January Anno Domini 1737. The above Described Tract of Land Was Surveyed Unto John Murray in Hanover Township & Lancaster County. Beginning at the Mouth of Run. Thence Up Swatara Creek 355 perches to a Black Oak. Thence by Vacant Land the & three several Courses (Viz) North by East 100 perches to a post, West by North 70 perches to a Post and North by East 60 perches to a White Oak. Thence West by North by the Improvement of Adam Read 40 perches to a White Oak. Thence South 77 Degrees West by the Same 80 perches to a Post by $\frac{A}{N}$ Run. Then Down the Same on the several Courses thereof to y^e place of Beginning. Containing Two Hundred Acres beside the Allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent.
