

VACANT LAND



VACANT Land.

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 21st Day of January Anno Dom 1735. for Surveying unto Adam Kreil one hundred Acres of Land in the County of Lancaster near the Head of Conestoga Creek, adjoining to John Miley's Land, there was surveyed A certain Tract of Land situate in the sd County. Beginning at a marked White Oak at a Corner of the sd John Miley's Land Thence extending by the same & vacant Land South 24 Deg^s West to a small black Oak marked Eighty one perches, Thence South 60 Deg^s East One hundred & forty seven perches to a small hickry marked & North 30 Deg^s East One hundred & thirty three perches to a small Chestnut marked & North 60 Deg^s West One hundred & forty perches, the Three last Courses & Distances by vacant Land. Thence by John Miley's Land South 24 Deg^s West fifty one perches & North 66 Deg^s West 20 perches to the place of Beginning. Containing One hundred & fourteen Acres & a quarter of an Acre, & the usual Allowance of 6 $\frac{2}{3}$ Cent. for Roads &c⁹. Survey'd the 20th Day of December Anno Domini 1737.
