In pursuance of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 10th day of April 1741, requiring me to Resurvey to Hannah Morris, a Lot of Ground to her belonging, situate on the West side of Delaware Front Street, between Michael Koyle's and Thomas Hatton's lots, & to bound the same on the West by the East side of Dock Street, according to the late Regulation thereof: - on the 27th day of May 1741 I have Resurveyed the said Lot & bounded the same accordingly. The limits whereof are now as follow, viz^t Bounded Eastw^d by Delaware Front St^t contain^g in breadth by the same 19 1/2 feet, Southw^d by Tho^s Hatton's lot contain^g in length by the same 121 ft, bounded Westw^d by the East side of Dock Street contain^g in breadth by the same 19 ft 9 inches & ~~on the~~ Northward by Michael Koyle's lot contain^g in length by the same 123 ft. The shaded part is Swampy ground not included within the first Survey. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 28th of May 1741.
