Dom. 1823, for Joseph Musser and Catharine Chambers Executors of the last Will and Testament of Robert Chambers, Dec^d. Containing three hundred and eleven Acres and one hundred and twenty four perches with the Usual Allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent &c.
