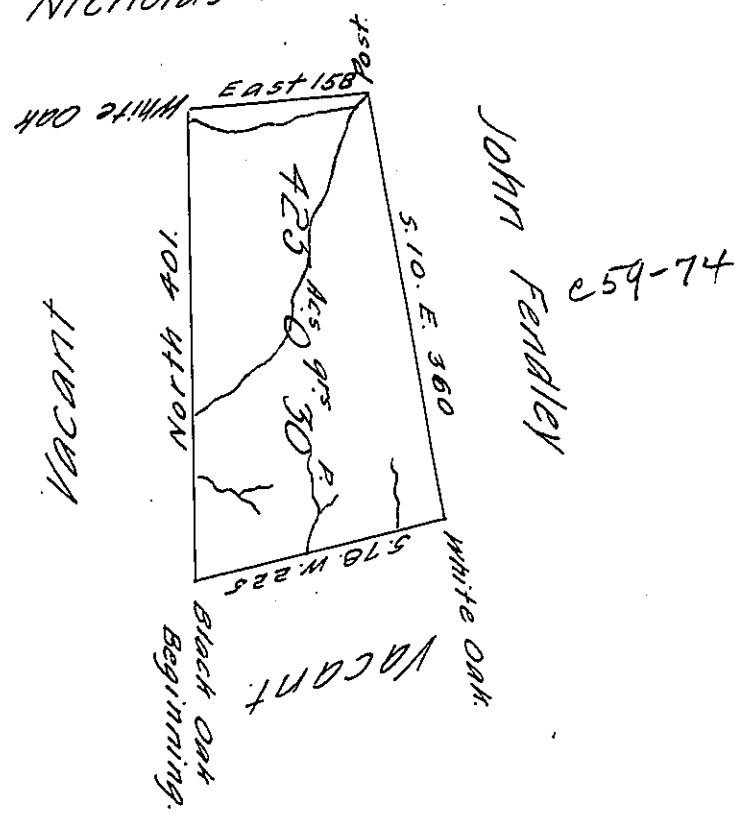

The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 16th day 1794, in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Mitzger for 400 Acres of Land, Dated the tenth day of February 1794, Adjoining Nicholas Bousman to the Eastward, and on the South Side of the Conaquesnessing Creek, Cornering on the bank of said Creek North and West of the River Ohio &c. Called Mulberry. Containing four Hundred and twenty five Acres and thirty poles together with the Usual Allowance of Six p^{ct} Cent for Roads.
