It being part of a tract of land Surveyed the 26<sup>th</sup> March Anno Dom. 1777, in pursuance of a Warrant to Baltes Cline Smith dated the 21 February 1776 per William Maclay, Esq, then Deputy Surveyor. Resurveyed the 22<sup>d</sup> day of January Anno Dom. 1823
