



Draught of eighty nine acres and one hundred and forty five perches of land with Six per Cent.—situate in Fermanagh township, in Mifflin county which is part of a tract of land surveyed 3^d December 1768, in pursuance of an order to, or application of Denman Beris dated 29th July 1768, numbered 5117, said to contain 176 acres. Resurveyed and divided 8th May 1809, and the whole found to contain 175.9 & 126 perches with Six per Cent.
