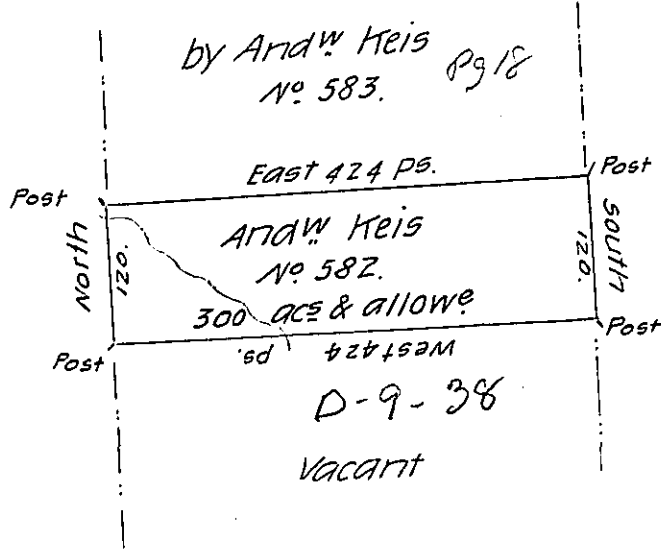

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 23^d day of June 1785, No 582, the above described tract of land, situate on the the Waters of Andersoris Creek on the Road leading from the West branch of Sasquahanna - to Lake Erie about seven Miles from the Mouth of said Creek now in Clearfield County there was surveyed the 25th day of April 1793 - Three hundred acres of Land and usual allowance of Six P. Cert & c^a for Andrew Keis by James Hunter late deputy Surveyor "for last purchase district No 4.
