

Land: this being done, I found, that, in the sd Line, there was a Surplus of 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ perches. I then knew of no other way to proceed, that would be likely to bring ^{the} thing to Rights, but to strike of this Surplus. which I did by running a Line, nearly parralell to that of Thomas's, from the extent of the sd 123 ps. from sd Blearn's Land, to the Extent of the aforesd 15 p from the W. Oak by sd Lewis's Land, making vacant better than 24 a that before was thought patented. This last Line, in the patent, is mentioned to be 206 ps. whereas, as may be seen by the Draught, I make it only 191.8 ps. falling short 14.2 ps. the Reason of which must be, that either the 75 Pole Line is so much longer than the patent specifies (which I doubt) or else one, or th' other of the opposite Lines are so much shorter; but which, as I did not ^{try} them, I cannot determine.
