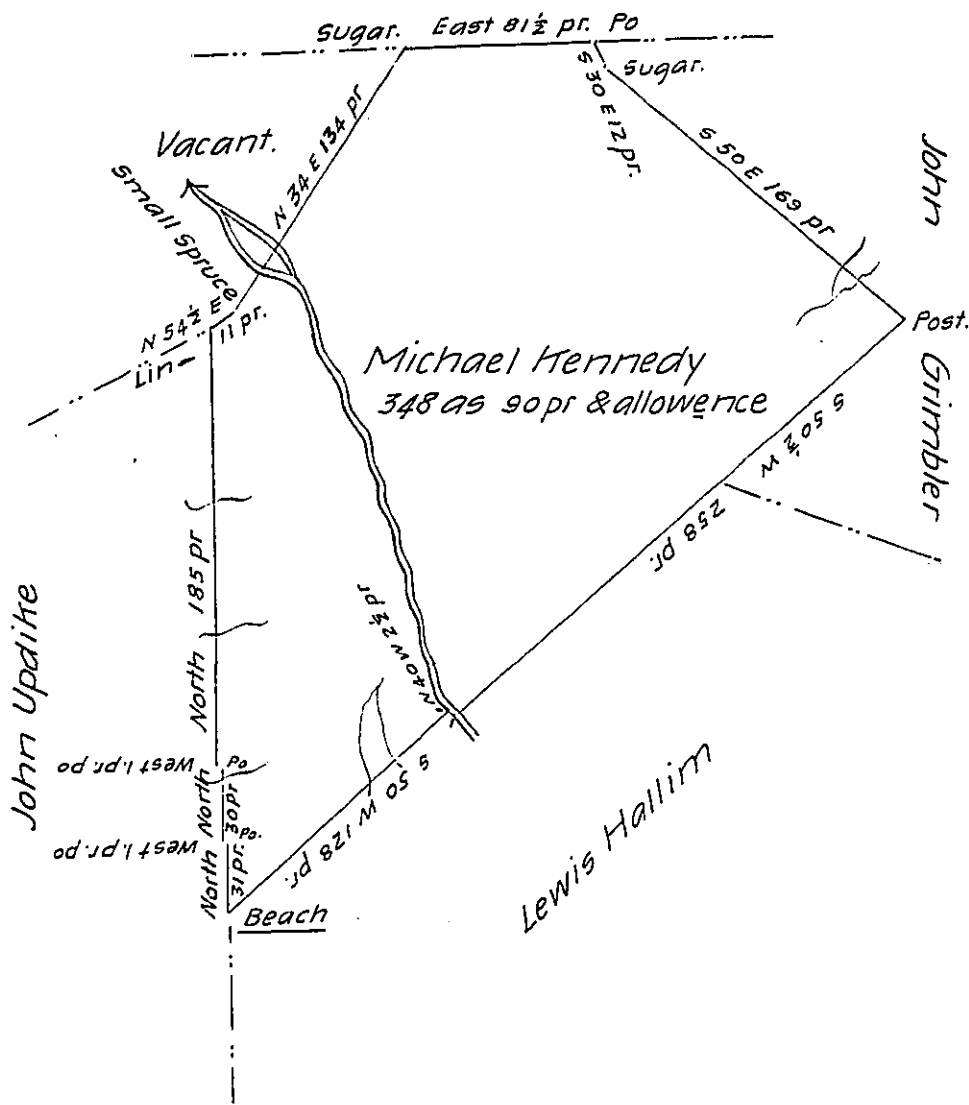


James C. Fishers land.
