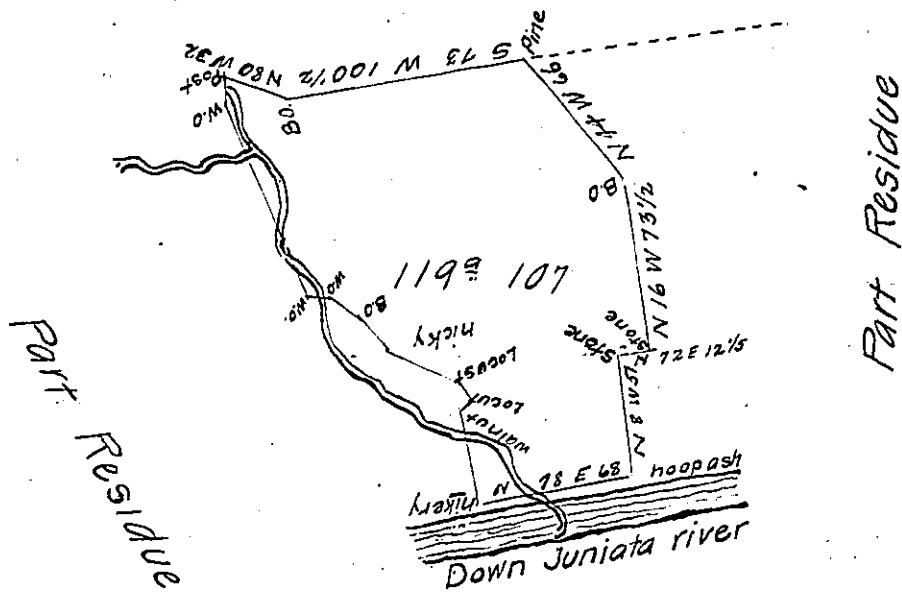

The above part resurveyed and divided off said tract 22nd Jan^y 1800 Examined 28th Feb^y 1811
