



A draught of a tract of land Situate in the Township of Brantrim in the County of Luzerne on the Main branch of Big Mehooppeny Creek including the improvement of Joseph Lott Containing two hundred and thirteen acres and thirty nine perches and allowance of six per cent for roads the improvements Comenced the first day of June 1800 and consist in a dwelling house for Many years and Still continues to be the residence of a family and upward of ten acres of land Cleared & fenced Survey to Joseph Lott the 20th day of August 1811. In pursuance of a warrant dated the twenty fourth day of July A.D. 1811
