



A Draught of a peice of land situate in Washington Town-
 ship Franklin County Containing seven acres and fifty five
 perches and the usual allowance of six P. Cent for roads &c.
 Surveyed August 24th 1811 in persuance of a warrant granted
 to John Halm dated May 23rd 1792.

I do certify that their was no improvement on the
 above survey at the time of executing the above mentioned
 Warrant, except that the land was clear, which appeared to have
 been done about 15 or 20 years.
