



A draught of one hundred and seventy four acres and twenty one perches of land with six per cent for roads situate in Fermanagh township in Mifflin county which is part of a tract of land surveyed in pursuance of a warrant to William Henderson dated 10th June 1762. Said to contain 426 acres & 40 perches Resurveyed the above part 17th August 1809.

Note, The date of the division is not to me known; but it appears from official papers remaining in the Deputy Surveyors Office in Mifflintown in and for Mifflin county to have been done officially.
