



Situate on Beauty's run a small stream that empties into Lycorning Creek on the west side about four and an half miles from its mouth in Lycorning Township and County, re-survey'd the 11<sup>th</sup> day of September 1810 for Samuel E. Grier in pursuance of an order from the Board of Property dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1810, containing Two hundred and thirty four acres & one hundred and twenty three perches and allowance of six pr. cent for roads &c
