for David Harriman by virtue of his warrant for 70 acres of land  
dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1800 Situate in Washington County  
on the waters of Buffaloe-including his improvement adjoining lands  
of David Bines Elizabeth Buckannon & others called (Bush Nob.)  
Containing fifty nine acres and seventy one perches together with six  
~~per cent~~ allowance of six per cent for roads.
