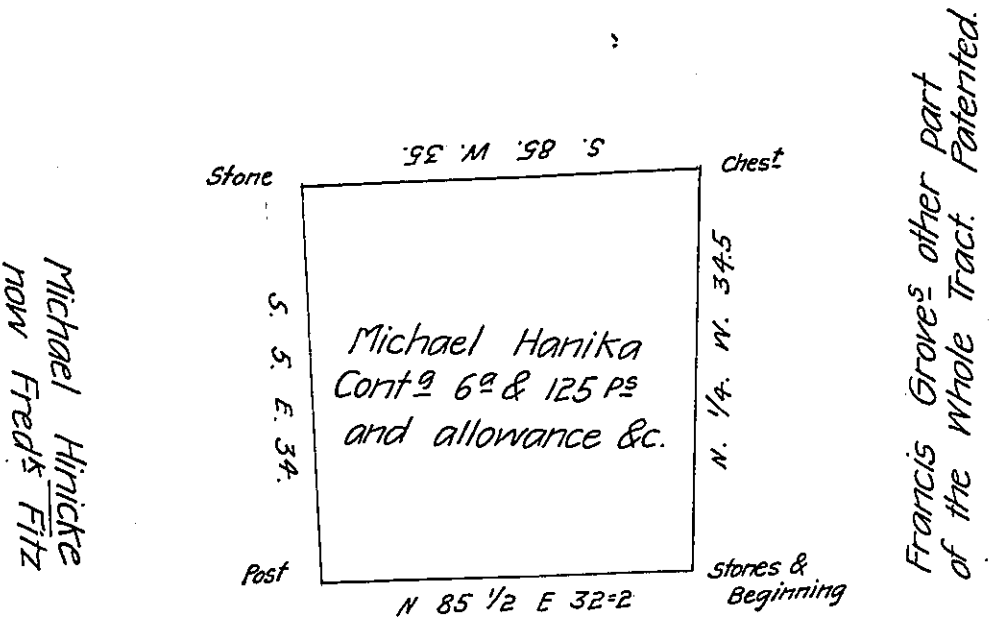


FRANCIS GROVE
