



By virtue of a warrant granted to Samuel McKibbon for 230 acres of Land dated January the 30th 1787, the above described tract of land containing two hundred sixty one acres and eighty six perches and the usual allowance of six p. c^t for roads, Situate on the Waters of Cross Creek in Washington County Was surveyed on the 20th of March 1788 by Presley Nevill and Matthew Ritchey Esquires late deputy Surveyors as appears by the record in the survey book kept by Nevill & Ritchey and now examined and certified to be correct this 18th day of February 1808.
