 Containing as above set forth 4^{es} & 144 perches & allowance.
 Being part of a larger Tract of 12^{es} & allowance, which was
 Originally Surveyed by Moses McClean late DS on the 28th
 day of May 1790 for Ulrich Hooper in pursuance of a warrant
 for 20^{es} granted to James Moore bearing date the 29th
 day of June 1789. Resurveyed and divided off from the said
 Larger Tract of Land in the month of December 1805. And now
 at the request of the present owner Jacob Keller I am desired
 to make return of the Draught as calculated examined and
 corrected the 22^d day of August A D^o 1809. per
 To Andrew Porter Esq^r Surveyor General. Jacob Spangler DS
 Lancaster P^a (N.B. It is probable the whole tract of which
 the above is a part was returned in the name of Ulrich Hooper
 in right of James Moore.
