



A Draught of twenty six acres and one hundred and ten perches of land with six per cent for Roads, situate in Derry Township in Mifflin County, surveyed 11th September 1812 in pursuance of a Warrant to Henry Long dated 29th August 1812.

Note. Improvement on this land at time of Survey a large Cabbⁱⁿ house and a family living in it, ~~at time of Survey~~ and an acre of land cleared, under fence, and in a state of Cultivation.
