



Draft of a tract of land situate in Limestone township Warren County. South & East of the Allegheny River. Containing eight hundred and ninety five acres & forty perches of land &c. Surveyed for Lewis F. Watson. Which said tract of land was surveyed on a Warrant granted to LeRoy & Linklain. Numbered 3103 for 900 acres & dated the 13th day of December 1792, and by survey of the 13th Sept 1794. made to contain 1107 $\frac{1}{4}$ ^{as}. But by actual survey found to contain 895^{as} 40 P^s as aforesaid. The two tracts No^s 3017 & 3064 lying & adjoining on the east being previously laid & issued and the lines clearly defined as shown above the red dotted lines would show the interference.
