



Situate on the Waters of Gists Run, a branch of Dunbars run in Dunbar township Fayette County & Surveyed the 12th day of September 1834. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 1st day of September 1834 for 85 acres in the name of Louis Lowry there is about 7 or 8 acres of this land which appears as if it had been cleared about 30 years also a new Cabbin erected on or about the 3^d Sept 1834 by Isaac Mason who claims the land by purchase of the man who made the first Improvement. he has John Brown & family residing in said Cabbin as tenants.

Mason requests a caveat to be intered against the acceptance of this survey, and that Patent may not Issue to Lowry untill a hearing can be had before the Hon. Board of Property or a decision in Court.
