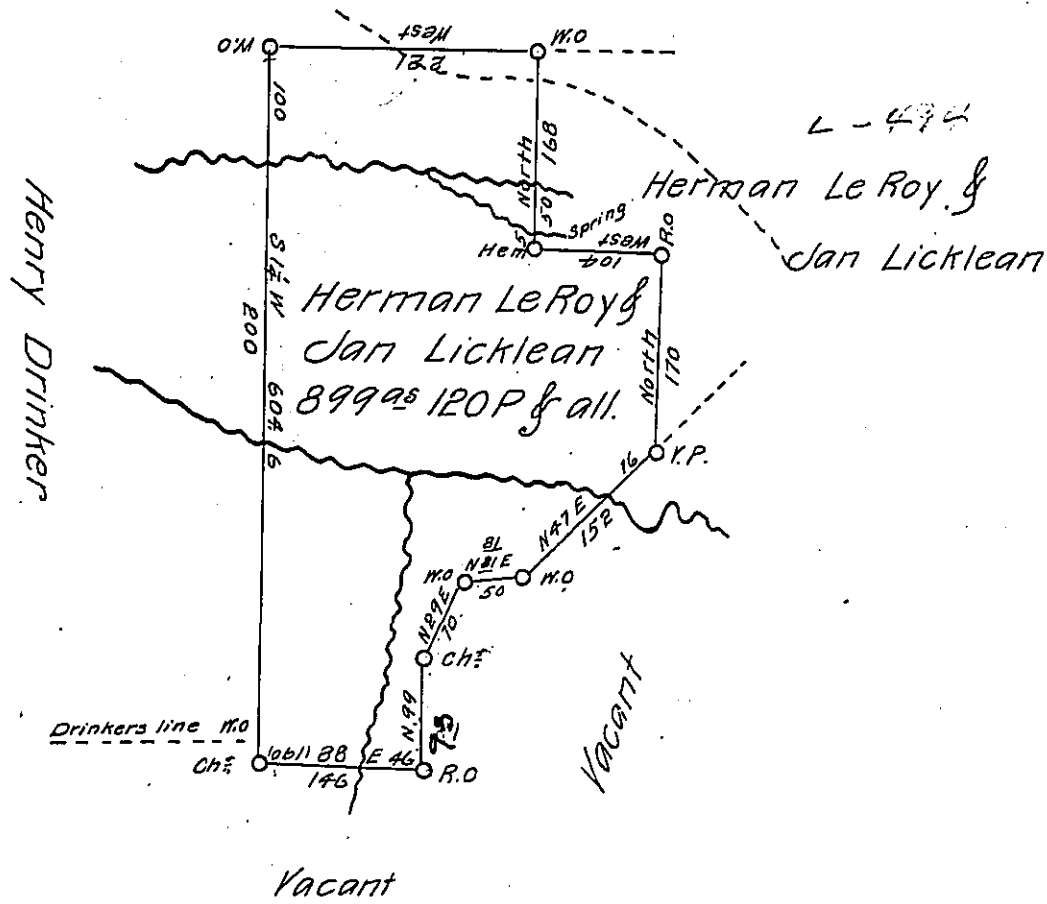


Henry Drinker
