



In Pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property dated the 24<sup>th</sup> of November 1789. Directing the above Plott of 131<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> & 130 perches to be Confirmed on the Application of Leonard Imble for 150<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>. Dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of September 1767 the same was laid off by Survey and a Return made thereof into the Surveyor Generals, and Now at the request of the Administrator of Thomas Metzler. I was desired to furnish him with the above draught directed to the Surveyor General containing one hundred and thirty one acres and one hundred and thirty perches and allowance as is above described on S<sup>d</sup> App<sup>t</sup> No 4383. Situate in Newbury Town<sup>sh</sup>.
