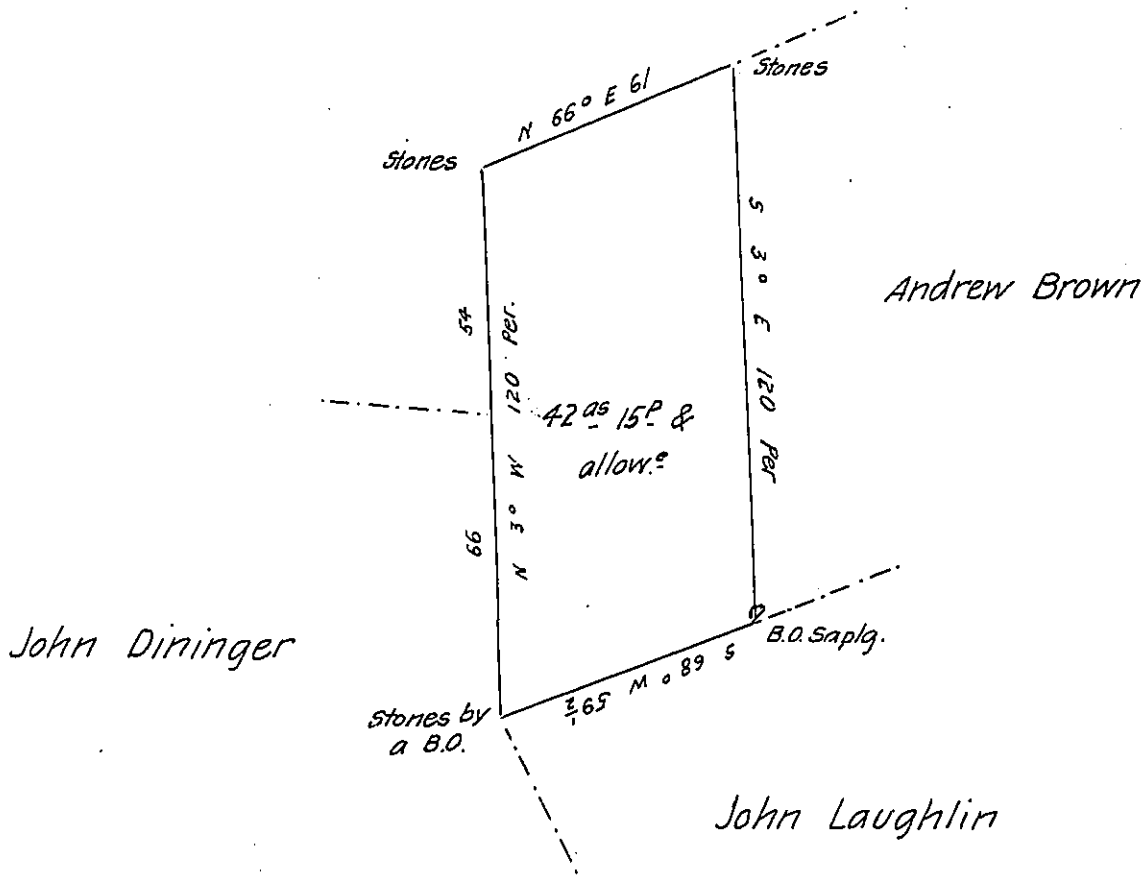


Blue Mountain
