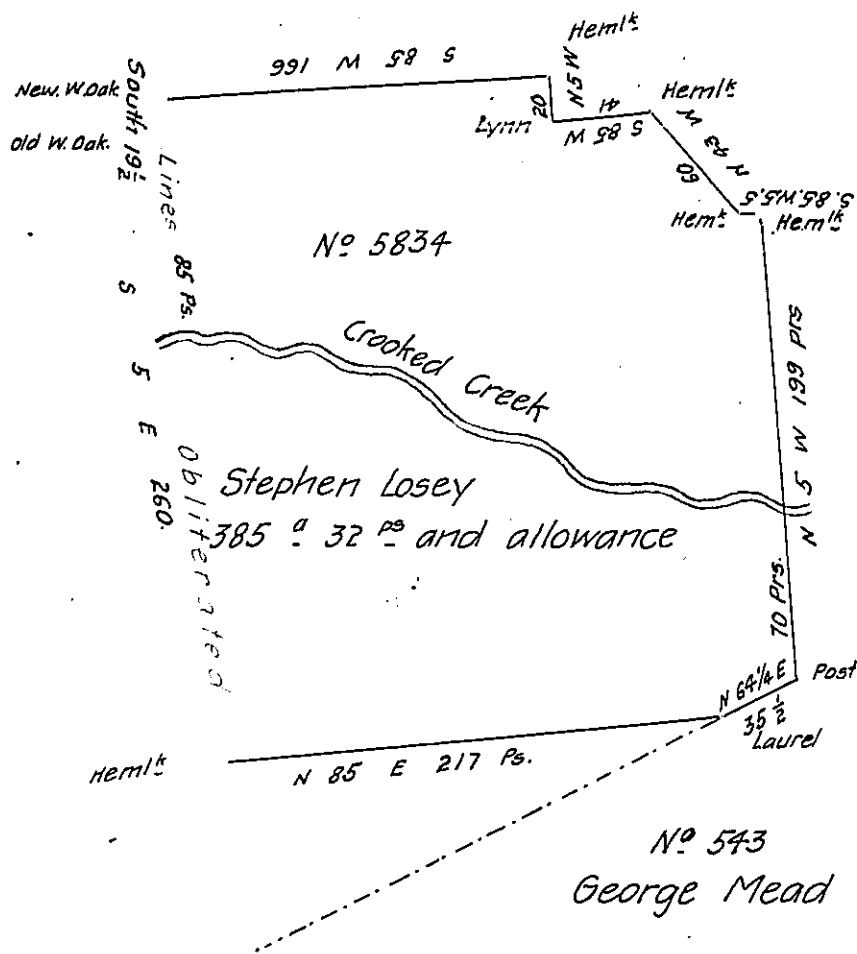


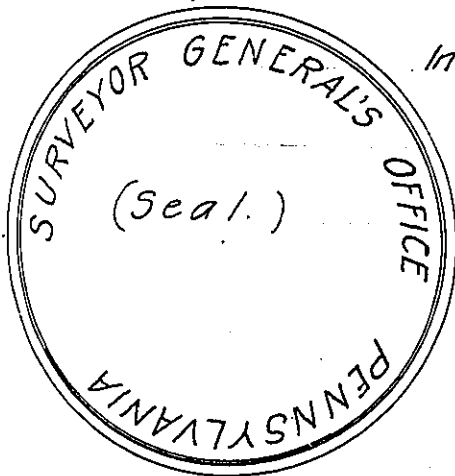

The draft of a tract of land situate near the mouth of Crooked Creek a part of the South branch of Tioga river in the County of Tioga Containing three hundred and eighty five acres and thirty two perches and the allowance of six per cent. Surveyed partly on September the 26th 1815 and partly on May the 24th 1816 in pursuance of a warrant to Stephen Losey N^o 5834 dated the 5th day of October 1802, for an improvement right, which settlement was continued by a family then residing on the land and the improvement made appeared abundantly sufficient for the support of a family...The land has been improved for more than eighteen years.
