



Situate now in Brothers Valley Township Somerset County Including two Improvements & Surveyed (In pursuance of two Warrants Viz one in Jacob Stutsmans name dated 2nd November 1792 for 100^a the other in the name of Michael Kurtz for 150 Acres dated the 3rd day of May 1792.) By Alexander McClean Esquire late Deputy Surveyor on the 3rd day of December 1792—as appears by his Official Draught remaining in my Office—and now Certified this 1st day of february 1812 by me.

N.B. The Improvements on those two tracts of land were began as 'tis stated in the respective Warrants and thereof I am well informed: both tracts are requested in one Patent to Jacob Stutsman
