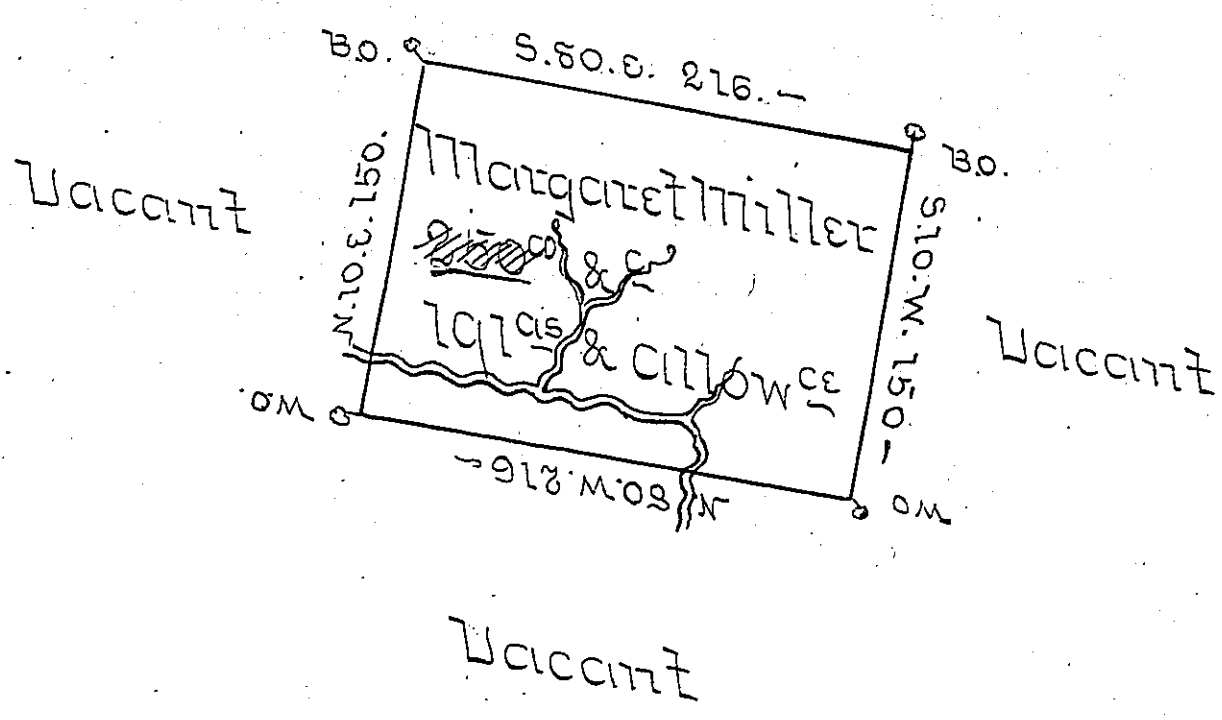


Vacant Mountain
