



Situate on the south side of the Praystown branch of the Junjata river in Providence (now West Providence) township Bedford County containing 98 acres 83 perches and allowance of 6 per Cent for roads &c. Surveyed for Ezekiel Cook by James Piper Esq and resurveyed the 23rd day of August 1851 in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property to Ezekiel Cook dated the 16th July 1851.

Being part of a larger tract of land containing 429 1/4 acres Surveyed for John Livingston the 6th of June 1791 on warrant dated the 25th of October 1784
