



Situate on the North side of the Faystown branch of the Juniata river in West Providence Township Bedford County Containing 168 acres 31 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 22nd of September 1851 for Daniel Fitchey the present owner and is composed of parts of two tracts of land viz - 125^{acs} 31^{ps} being part of a tract surveyed for John Livingston the 6th of June 1791 on Warrant date 25th of October 1784 containing 42^{9/4} acres and allowance and 43 acres being part of a tract containing 111 acres and allowance. Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted in the name of Henry Leader for 100 acres dated the 2nd of December 1813
