



Situate in the Townships of Paradise and Dover in the County of York, Containing within the black lines as above set forth 199 95 153 perches and allowance, being part of a larger tract of 203 3/4 as of land, which was originally surveyed by Charles Lukrens, late D.S. on the 19th day of September 1770 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Henry Leinbacher bearing date the 30th day of May 1744. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract the 8th day of December 1821 and now at the instance of the present owner the same has been calculated examined found to be correct and returned for confirmation November 24th 1825
