



In pursuance of a Warrant dated Jan<sup>y</sup>. 15<sup>th</sup> 1794 there was survey'd for Robert M<sup>e</sup> Knight the above described Tract of land containing Four Hundred acres and ninety two perches with an allowance proportioned to six p. c<sup>t</sup> for Roads &c., adjoining Land of Robert Fulton and others in Fairfield Township Westmoreland County. Survey'd May 7<sup>th</sup> 1794.
